

Message from Pastor Sean

"For surely I know the plans I have for you, says the Lord, plans for your welfare and not for harm, to give you a future with hope."

(Jeremiah 29:11)

We are in the season of Lent – a time for prayer, fasting, repentance, spiritual renewal. Many people will "give something up" during Lent – things like chocolate or coffee. But rather than simply giving something up, why not add something. Add a time for a new spiritual practice or resume a spiritual practice that you have neglected. You can add keeping a gratitude journal and each day write things that you are grateful for each day. You can add a practice like performing a random act of kindness each day. You can add a practice like being environmentally aware and practice being a good steward of God's creation – the earth, the water, the creatures. You can add a practice like intentionally praying throughout your day – maybe in the morning, at noon, in the evening and at bedtime.

There are many ways to grow closer to God and each other during the Lenten season and the benefits will linger long past Lent. Jesus made the ultimate sacrifice, the least that we can do is to honor Christ through our own spiritual practices and when you think about it our sacrifices are very small for the reward that we receive.

Happenings at WELC

A Message from your Council

Your Council wants to thank everyone who attended the Woodsboro Evangelical Lutheran Church (WELC) annual meeting on Sunday, February 26. We celebrated the successes we had in 2022 and discussed WELC's plans for 2023. We are very proud and thankful that we fulfilled on our 2022 priority of increasing our engagement with the greater Woodsboro Community. Thank you to our members, friends, neighbors, volunteers and visitors for making 2022 a success. A copy of the materials reviewed at the Annual meeting were emailed to our entire list in advance, if you desire another copy, please contact the church office.

As you recall, we committed 2022 to reengaging with the Community and increasing our presence. A major tactic in doing this was to hire Pastor Sean as our full-time pastor, the first full-time pastor that WELC has had in many years. This, along with the commitment of our members, friends and volunteers, allowed us to conduct almost 75 events / activities aimed at serving our Community resulting in over 5,000 touch points with the Community. THANK YOU to everyone. Some of the key activities in 2022 were:

- Our NEW Community dinners served on the first Tuesday of each month
- A very successful Vacation Bible School (over 35 students)
- Youth outreach via a Church Halloween Party
- Very active Holiday Season (Bazaar, Concert, Special Services)
- Many other traditional activities (yard sales, pot -pie, etc.)

We are committed to continuing and expanding upon these activities in 2023.

Our WELC Priorities and Goals for 2023 are:

- 1. Expanded Pastoral Care and Engagement Pastor Sean will visit shut-ins monthly and will personally reach out to all members / friends during 2023
- 2. **Community Support and Engagement** Expand on our outreach and engagement with the Community
- 3. Member / Friend Engagement While attendance at Sunday service increased in 2022 and we continue to have significant member / friend support at our events – we want to reengage with many members and friends that possibly aren't aware of the impact that WELC is having

4. Awareness and Transparency – We want to increase the awareness of our activities through Social Media, our website and other traditional communication channels. We plan to expand our website to allow for transactions (dinner orders, VBS registration, etc.). Transparency of our activities, the impact we are having, and our financial needs will be enhanced and expanded upon.

Our budget is approaching \$200,000 annually (this includes salaries and benefits for a full-time Pastor, a Music Director, Organist, Secretary and Sexton, facilities / Property costs, office costs, and Community engagement Costs). We rely on the generosity of our members and friends, through donations, as a primary source of revenue. WELC needs all of us to consider increasing our support to cover the operating costs of the church. Thank you to those in attendance for approving the annual budget for 2023.

Council members were also voted in for 2023, they include Peggy Esworthy, Marilyn Lenhart, Jay Lind, Roger Myers, John Nash, Brian Rippeon and Mitzi Smith. Thank you to these members for volunteering to serve.

We look forward to a great year in 2023 and have several requests of you:

- 1. If you have any ideas regarding Community or Member Engagement, please feel free to contact Pastor Sean or any Council member.
- 2. Plan to volunteer at any event that you may be interested in you will probably find that is a lot of fun!
- Pastor Sean is a great cook and does a great job at the Community dinners – You are invited, bring your family or a friend. Also, consider joining us for worship on Sunday morning at 10 am.
- 4. Pass the word along (about WELC events and activities) to your friends or neighbors, follow us on Facebook or Instagram or on the Website.
- 5. Finally, Lutherans usually don't like to talk about money, but as we previously mentioned, our budget is almost \$200,000. We are very thankful for your continued support and ask that you consider whether you can contribute a little more in support of our efforts.
