I have been thinking a lot about faith; about my faith and about others faith. What do we mean when we talk (or more likely think) about our faith. It seems to me that faith is more than a belief we hold in our minds — it is the steady rhythm that carries us through seasons of joy, uncertainty, and growth. Scripture reminds us in Hebrews 11:1 that *“faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.”* That single line captures both the mystery and the power of a life anchored in God.

At its core, faith is trust — not blind trust, but a confident assurance rooted in God’s character. When we look back over our lives, we see moments when God opened doors we didn’t expect, sustained us when we felt weak, and guided us when the path ahead was unclear. Those memories become the building blocks of a deeper, more resilient faith.

Faith also calls us into action. It invites us to step forward even when we cannot see the full picture. Think of Abraham, who followed God’s call without knowing the destination, or the disciples who left everything familiar to walk with Jesus. Their stories remind us that faith is not passive. It is lived out in our choices, our generosity, our compassion, and our willingness to trust God’s leading.

In our church community, we have the gift of walking this journey together. When one of us struggles, another lifts them up. When one rejoices, we all rejoice. This shared faith strengthens us and becomes a testimony to the world of God’s love at work.

As we move through this summer season, I encourage you to reflect on where God is inviting you to trust more deeply. What step of faith is God placing on your heart? What hope is God stirring within you?

May we continue to grow as a people who walk by faith, not by sight, confident that God is already and always preparing the way ahead.
